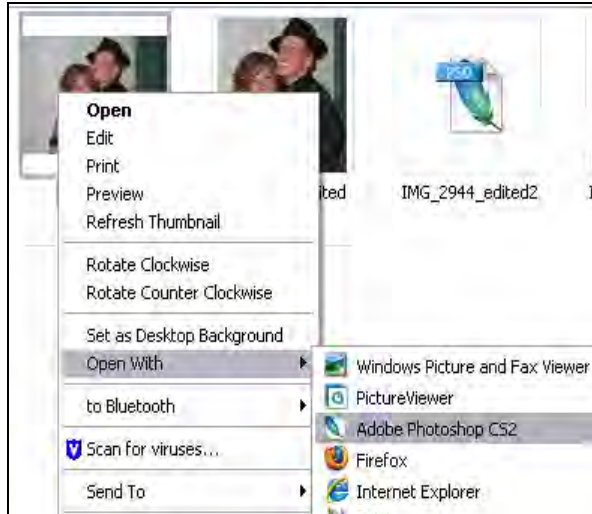


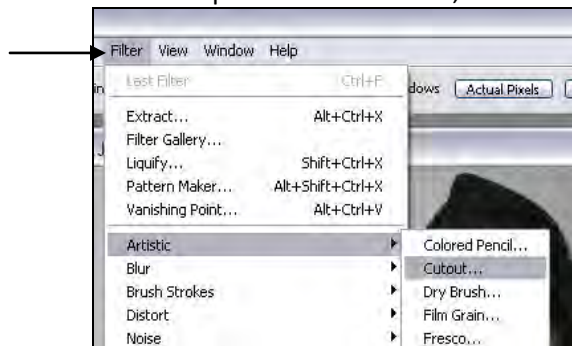
How to make a picture into a cutout in Photoshop

for high-school students

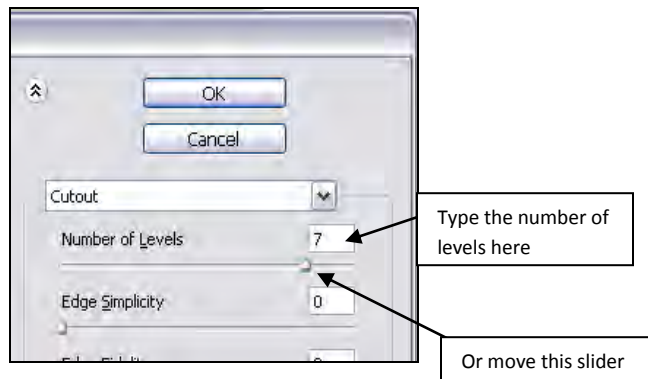
Step 1: Open your picture in Photoshop by right clicking on your picture and selecting **Open With** and choose **Adobe Photoshop CS2**.



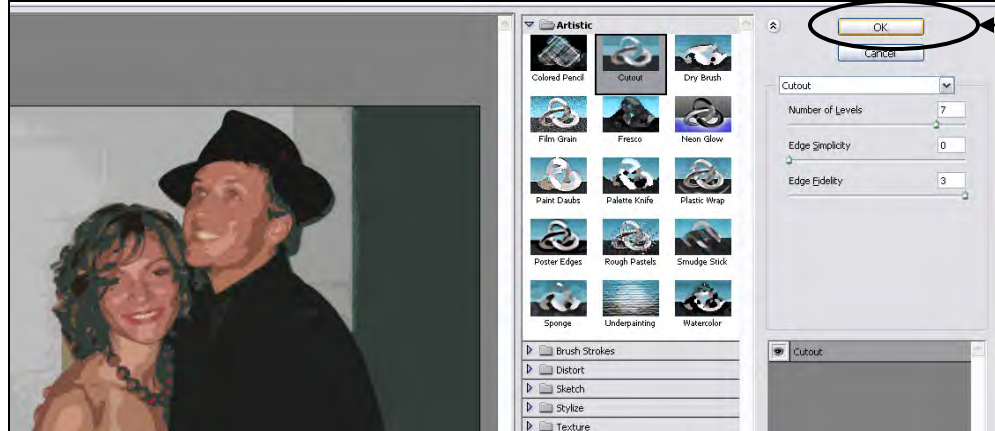
Step 2: When the picture opens, select the **Filter** option on the toolbar, and select **Artistic** and **Cutout...**



Step 3: When the filter box opens, you can change the number of levels (how many colors there are in the cutout--7 is usually a good number.) by clicking on the slider and dragging it, or just typing a number in the box.



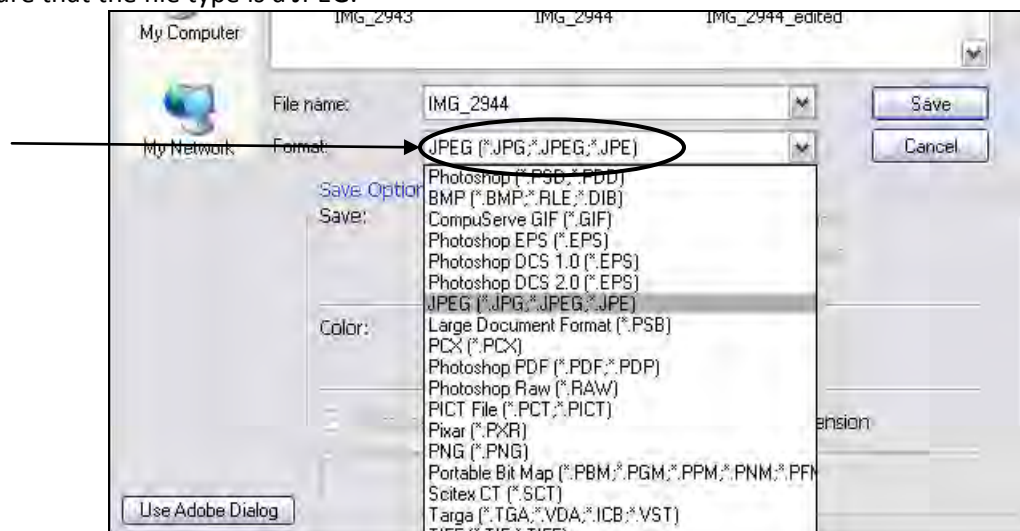
Step 4: When the picture appears in the window as you want it, click the **OK** button.



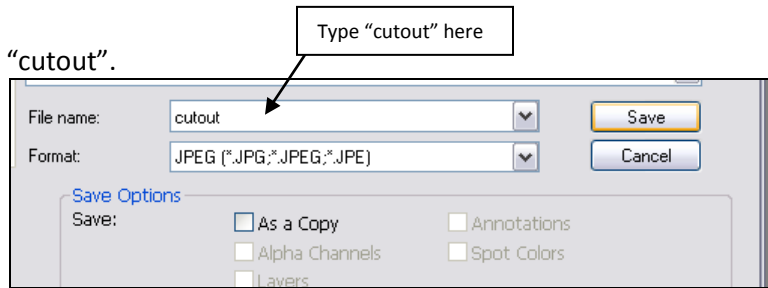
Step 5: When the filter box closes, save your new cutout by clicking **File** on the toolbar, and selecting **Save As**.



Step 6: Make sure that the file type is a JPEG.



Step 7: Change the file name to “cutout”.



Step 8: Click **Save**.
